

Now, the Max Suspension brings next-level comfort into the mix.

Its custom-developed front fork with 80mm of travel smooths out cobblestones, cracks, and potholes like a dream. You'll float through the city and beyond.

Still fast, still confident, and now even more comfortable.

Engineered the Ellio way

At Ellio, "off the shelf" usually isn't in our vocabulary.

Because our bikes run on all-wheel drive, simply adding a standard fork wasn't an option. So we went back to the drawing board, redesigning the front motor with a thru-axle and pairing it with a specially selected RST Blade suspension fork.

The result? A front suspension that's not just added on, it's built in. Seamless. Stable. 100% Fllio.

Sleek. Simple. Smart.

The minimalist cockpit that riders love from the Ellio Original now comes standard on both the Max and Max Suspension.

The new setup ditches the left-side button cluster and junction box for a refined display and single-hand control on the right.

It's cleaner, lighter, and just as intuitive. Designed for riders who like their tech to stay out of the way.

FAQ

Can I upgrade my current Ellio Max with the new suspension fork?

Unfortunately, no. Due to certification rules, retrofitting isn't possible. The suspension fork and motor were designed as one integrated system, making them incompatible with the existing Max frame and drive setup.

What happens to the Kinekt suspension stem?

Both the fixed-fork and suspension versions of the Max will now come without a suspension stem by default. But the Kinekt stem remains available as an optional upgrade for both models.
